Hugs from afar. See you this winter.

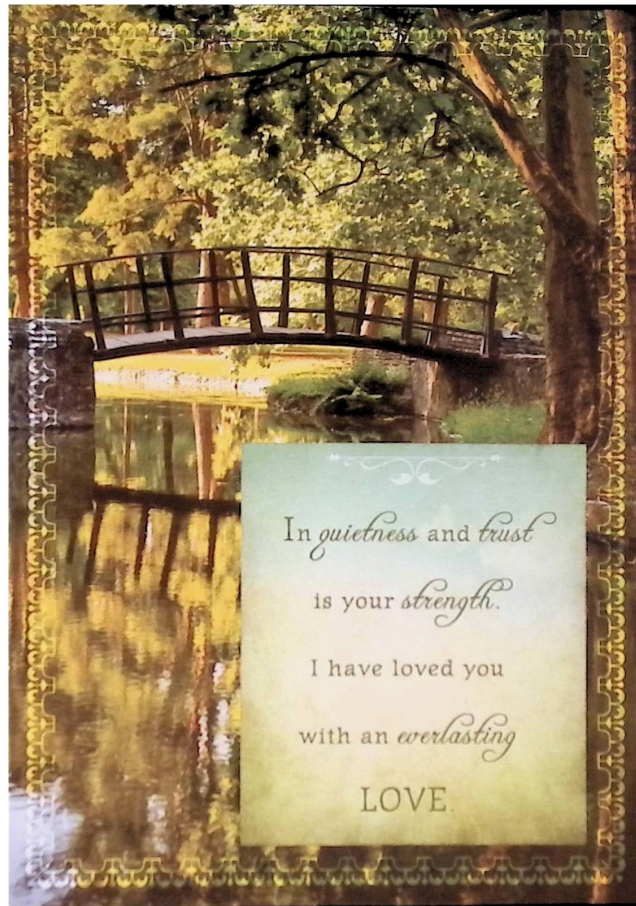

My heart grieves with you.

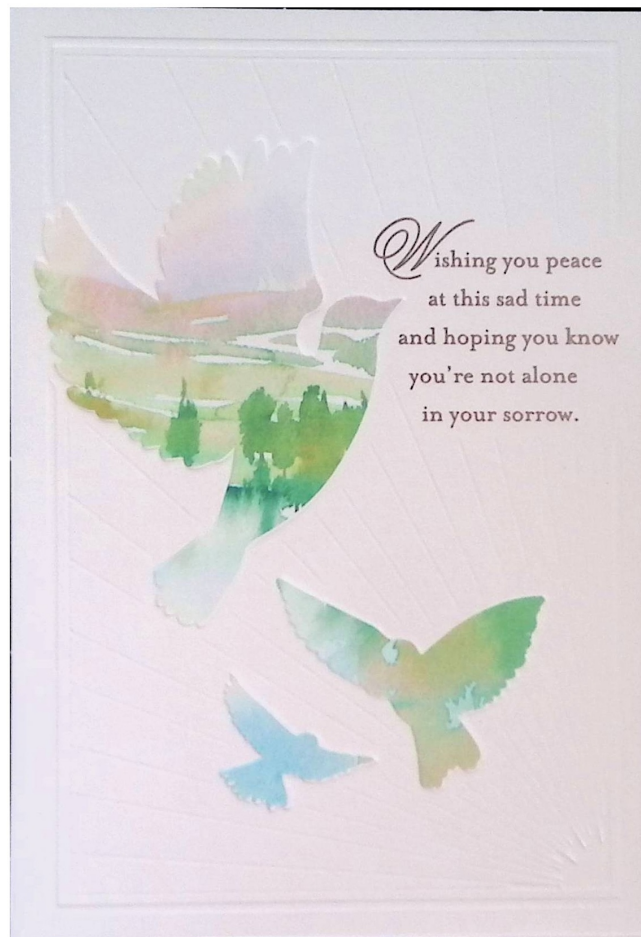
