Please RSVP either by reply email, or call at (408) 249-0550 (leave a message if we're not there). If you need a map, just let us know.

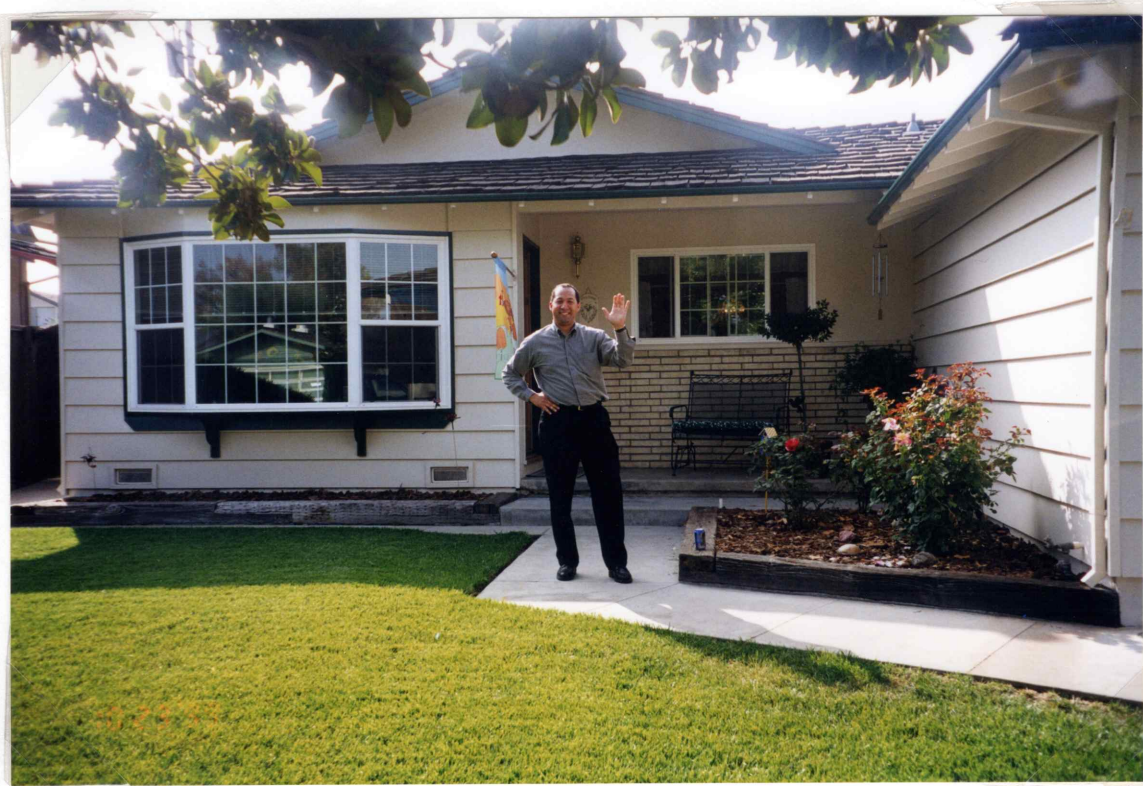
